**Beyond the Bell Program**

This three-hour, after school program is provided by a grant from the state to assist students improve their academic progress. Three other schools in our district also have this program: Monta Loma, Landels and Crittenden. Each school wrote their grant plan to address the specific needs of their site. At Theuerkauf School, we offer assistance with homework completion to students in third through fifth grade who have demonstrated initiative, have scored below proficient on the California Standards tests, do not receive other supplemental support but do have parental support. A list of all eligible students has been compiled for the 60-student program. An invitation/letter to participate has been sent to the first 68 students. Other letters will be sent when space is available. Students with disruptive behaviors have been excluded from the list.
